Children left unsupervised during the booking	Increased risk of injury, unsafe behaviour, or distress	Children	The venue operates as a self-serve space. Supervising adults are responsible for the safety and supervision of children at all times. The named booker is responsible for ensuring appropriate supervision throughout the booking.
Children left alone with unfamiliar adults	Safeguarding concern or inappropriate interaction	Children	Children must remain under the supervision of their parent or responsible adult. The named booker is responsible for ensuring children are not left unsupervised with unfamiliar adults.
Children entering toilets alone with unrelated adults	Safeguarding concern due to privacy areas	Children	Toilet facilities are considered private areas. Supervising adults should accompany young children where necessary. Adults should not enter toilet areas with children who are not in their care unless assistance is required and appropriate supervision is present.
Children becoming separated from supervising adults	Distress, confusion, or potential safety risk	Children	Adults responsible for monitoring the whereabouts of children in their care at all times. The open layout of the venue supports visibility across activity areas.



Children moving between floors without supervision	Trips, falls or unsafe behaviour on stairs	Children	Supervising adults responsible for managing children's movement between floors and ensuring safe use of stairways.
