Wet floors from handwashing or spills	Slips resulting in minor injury	Children, adults	Flooring suitable for washroom use. Guests are encouraged to wipe up excess water or spills. Area checked and left clean at the end of the booking.
Poor hygiene or unclean facilities between uses	Spread of germs or unpleasant environment	All guests	Cleaning materials provided. Guests expected to maintain reasonable cleanliness and follow the venue's leave-as-you-found-it approach. Facilities are checked before guests leave.
Children using facilities unsupervised	Slips, misuse of facilities, minor injury	Children	Supervising adults responsible for accompanying younger children where necessary.
Waste bins overflowing	Hygiene issues or obstruction	All guests	Bins provided and accessible. Guests are encouraged to dispose of waste properly and tie bags if full. Waste to be disposed of according to waste policy.
Water splashes around sinks	Slippery floor surface	Children, adults	Guests are encouraged to wipe surfaces if excessive water is present. Heavy-duty disposable wipes & antibacterial wipes are available if



			required.
Cleaning products stored in the area	Accidental contact or misuse by children	Children	Cleaning products stored appropriately and used by adults only. Guests are responsible for supervising children near cleaning supplies.
Items left on floor (paper towels, belongings)	Trips or slips	Children, adults	Guests are encouraged to keep floors clear and dispose of waste appropriately before leaving the venue.
