

Music & Noise Policy

This policy explains how music may be used during bookings and outlines expectations for maintaining reasonable noise levels. These guidelines help ensure an enjoyable atmosphere while respecting neighbours and the surrounding community.

1. Self-Serve Music

Music may be played during your booking.

- Guests are responsible for playing and controlling their own music.
 - Personal devices may be connected to the sound system where available.
 - Music content and volume remain the responsibility of the supervising adults.
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2. Volume Levels

Music should be kept at a reasonable and comfortable level.

- Volume must remain appropriate for an indoor environment.
 - Excessive bass or vibration should be avoided.
 - If noise becomes disruptive, volume must be reduced.
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3. Consideration for Neighbours

Please help us maintain a positive relationship with neighbours:

- Keep doors closed when music is playing.
 - Avoid excessive noise when arriving or leaving.
 - Supervise children outside the venue to prevent shouting or disturbance.
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4. Noise Management

If noise levels are considered excessive:

- you may be asked to reduce the volume immediately
 - continued disruption may result in further action being taken
